SHOW CONDITIONS

- 1. Run under ESNZ Rules
- 2. Entries close THURSDAY 11TH DEC AT 5.00PM
- 3. Stables & Covered Yards \$60 per horse for the show, Yards \$45 per horse/pony for the show.
 - a. We will endeavour to allocate yards as requested, however, covered yards and stables are limited, and we reserve the right to pro rata them as required.
 - b. All yarded or stabled equines must have their name, the name of the person responsible and the telephone number on their head collar and/or rug as per jumping rules 200.7.1
- 4. Camping fees \$45 per truck/caravan powered site; \$30 per truck/caravan non powered site.
- 5. Ground & first aid Levy \$ 50 per horse/pony. This is non-refundable
- 6. \$8.50 ESNZ Jumping Levy (Compulsory) payable by all horses/ponies competing in Jumping and/ or Show Hunter
- 7. All fees must be paid at the time of entering via POLi Payments. Entries will not be confirmed until full payment is received.
- 8. The secretary must be advised of all scratchings, class changes and late entries by 4.00pm the night before competition. Class scratchings will be refunded less 20% of entry fees (excluding on-line fees and ground and first aid levy). After closing date, class changes and late entries will occur a 30% surcharge on entry fees. Please note that on-line fees and the ground and first aid levy are non-refundable
- 9. Prize money and refunds will be paid out after the show to your nominated bank account.
- 10. Manawatu Equestrian reserves the right to change classes if circumstances warrant. Rings and starting times will be adhered to as closely as possible. Please note that starting times are approximate only.
- 11. Manawatu Equestrian reserves the right to cancel or refuse entry if circumstances warrant this.
- 12. The Kiwi Arena and Bright Stars Arena will be run in draw order, with the Kiwi Arena taking precedence. Sand Arenas One and Two will be run in blackboard order. Please remember to tell the judge if you are competing out of order.
- 13. All competitors enter at their own risk and abide by the Health & Safety Act and Manawatu Equestrians Health and Safety Policy. A display of hazards will be posted on the stabling notice board.
- 14. \$30.15 Casual Jumping Start; Rider must be a full member with ESNZ. Horse/Pony not registered for ESNZ J/SH can compete using this levy. This levy (includes \$25 Flexi Start) for the show, can jump up to 1.00 on a pony and up to 1.10m on a horse. Cannot compete in series classes and will not be eligible for HOY qualifying points in Show Hunter. Introductory membership or \$16.30 casual membership/event start Riders may compete in Introductory classes 80 cm and under for ponies and 90cm and under for horses on an Introductory membership or Casual Membership Day start.
- 15. Motorbikes are not to be ridden between 6.00pm and 6.30am. Motorbike riders must wear a helmet, must not carry passengers and must not be under the influence of alcohol or substances.
- 16. By entering the Kiwi Super Classic, you agree to your name and image being used for results and promotional purposes.

HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

Manawatu Equestrian are committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for everyone, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this. We will take all practicable steps by:

- Providing a safe event, safe equipment, and proper materials.
- Identifying and monitoring hazards and using the hazard management hierarchy of eliminate, isolate, or minimise.
- Insisting upon establishment of safe methods and best practices.
- Complying with all H&S legislation, regulations, and codes of practice. We will take responsibility for health and safety procedures, however, ALL PEOPLE ON THIS SITE need to be aware of their responsibilities and comply with the event's health and safety policy. EVERY PERSON involved in our show is encouraged to play a vital and responsible role in maintaining a safe and healthy event through:
- Being involved in the event health and safety system.
- Following correct procedures.
- · Ensuring safe and proper use of equipment.
- Wearing protective clothing and equipment as and when required.
- Reporting any pain or discomfort as soon as possible.
- Ensuring ALL accidents and incidents are reported to a Health & Safety Officer at the Office.
- Helping new employees, trainees, and visitors to understand the safety procedures and why they exist.
- Informing the office immediately of any health and safety concerns.
- Keeping the event facilities tidy to minimise the risk of any trips and falls.

COMPETITORS are responsible for themselves at ALL times and must observe the safe practices and the rules/instructions relating to their competition. In case of a fall of an athlete and/or horse at any time in the competition arena, in the practice arena, or elsewhere within the grounds of the event, the athlete must be checked by the event's medical service (or by a medical doctor if the medical service is not available) before he/she may be permitted to take part in the round in progress or in the next round or any competition at the event, respectively the horse must be cleared by the Veterinarian or President of the Ground Jury and one other official if the Veterinarian is not available, before it may be permitted to take part in the next round or any competition at the event.

Manawatu Equestrian complies with the ESNZ concussion policy. Riders who have a suspected concussion will be removed from the event. Riders who are concussed are often unaware of their symptoms and may want to continue riding. The Ground Jury at the event takes responsibility for the rider's wellbeing, assesses the rider and makes an informed choice about whether the rider should continue to ride or not – if any doubt the rider must be removed from the event.
